SPECIAL NOTICE - COVID-19 RELATED PROCEDURES IN EFFECT

Due to the state and local State of Emergency resulting from the threat of Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), Governor Newsom has issued Executive Order N-29-20 (issued March 17, 2020) in which Section 3 supersedes Paragraph 11 of Executive Order N-25-20 (issued on March 12, 2020). This new order states that WRCOG does not need to make a physical location available for members of the public to observe a public meeting and offer public comment. The purpose of this item is to provide an annual update for WRCOG's Supporting Foundation.

Requested Actions:

1. Approve the 4th Quarter Supporting Foundation Budget Amendment for Fiscal Year 2019/2020.

2. Adopt Resolution Number 01-20; A Resolution of the Board of Directors of the Western Riverside Council of Governments Supporting Foundation adopting the Fiscal Year 2020/2021 Foundation Budget.

The Supporting Foundation was created to allow for WRCOG to apply for grant funding that supports the efforts of WRCOG's various programs. In 2018, the Riverside County Habitat Conservation Agency (RCHCA) applied for a grant through the United States Department of Agriculture Natural Resource Conservation Service (NCRS). The Southwest Willow Flycatcher Initiative published by NCRS seeks to create suitable habitat for the species by removing invasive plants and restoring riparian areas.

4th Quarter Budget Amendment

RCHCA, which now operates under WRCOG's umbrella, was able to leverage WRCOG's Supporting Foundation and non-profit status to attain the grant in the amount of \$21,783. The Supporting Foundation received funds in the amount of \$8,239 in December 2019. A 4th quarter budget amendment is needed to reflect these funds received.

FY 2020/2021 Budget

As previously noted, the total anticipated grant amount is \$21,783 and the remaining amount of \$13,544 is anticipated to be received in Fiscal Year 2020/2021, which will require a budget adoption. RCHCA will continue to apply for grants that require non-profit status and is in the process of creating its own non-profit entity.

Prior Action:

<u>June 21, 2019</u>: The Supporting Foundation received and filed report for Fiscal Year 2018/2019; there

were no programs requiring additional financial support.

Fiscal Impact:

All known and expected revenues and expenditures impacting the Agency have been budgeted for Fiscal Year 2020/2021 but will be continually updated throughout the Budget process.
