The purpose of this item is to provide an annual update for WRCOG's Supporting Foundation.

# **Requested Action:**

1. Approve the 4th Quarter Supporting Foundation Budget Amendment for Fiscal Year 2020/2021.

# 4th Quarter Budget Amendment

The Riverside County Habitat Conservation Agency (RCHCA), which operates under WRCOG's umbrella, was able to leverage WRCOG's Supporting Foundation and non-profit status to attain a grant in 2018 through the United States Department of Agriculture Natural Resource Conservation Service (NCRS) for the Southwest Willow Flycatcher Initiative which was published by NCRS and sought to create suitable habitat for the species by removing invasive plants and restoring riparian areas.

The Supporting Foundation received additional funds in the amount of \$4,754 during Fiscal Year 2020/2021; therefore, a 4th quarter budget amendment is needed to reflect these funds received.

## FY 2021/2022 Supporting Foundation Budget

The WRCOG Supporting Foundation was created to allow for WRCOG to apply for grant funding that supports the efforts of WRCOG's various programs. RCHCA has now created its own non-profit, the Riverside Communities Partnership Project (RCPP), and will no longer be utilizing the WRCOG Supporting Foundation for additional grants, so there are no anticipated revenues or expenses for the Supporting Foundation for Fiscal Year 2021/2022.

June 1, 2020: The Supporting Foundation approved the 4th Quarter Supporting Foundation Budget

Amendment for Fiscal Year 2019/2020 and 2) adopted Resolution Number 01-20; A Resolution of the Board of Directors of the Western Riverside Council of Governments Supporting Foundation adopting the Fiscal Year 2020/2021 Foundation Budget.

# Fiscal Impact:

The 4th quarter budget amendment will reflect an additional \$4,754 for Fiscal Year 2020/2021.
